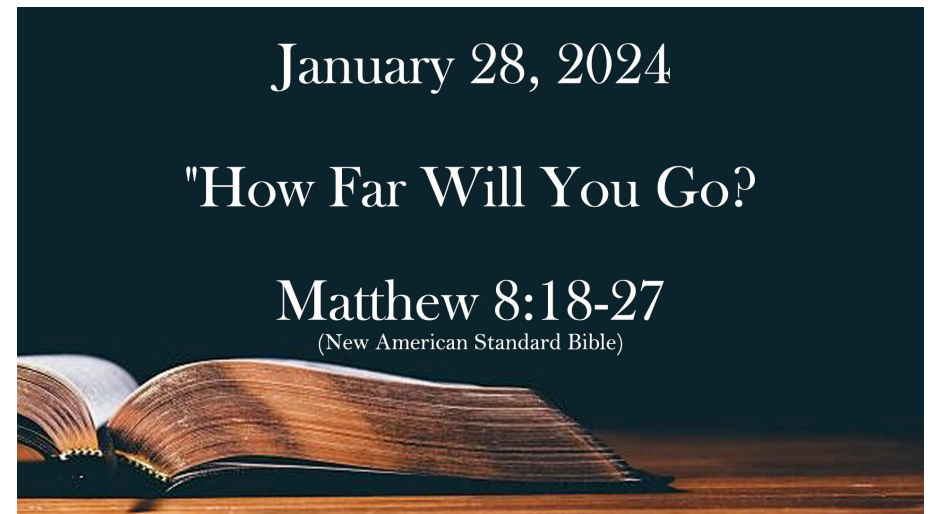

"Setting the Record Straight on the Righteousness of God"

I have learned that perceived necessity drives human behavior. The motivation for following Christ and proclaiming His Lordship supports this conjecture. We mostly turn to Christ during times of need and resist the call to accept His Lordship when self-righteousness prevails. When asked why He was eating with tax collectors and sinners in Matthew 9:12, Jesus stated that "it is not those who are healthy who need a physician, but those who are sick," and that "He did not come to call the righteous but sinners."

The implication here is that the darkness of sin can only be overcome by the light of God's righteousness and those who are able to provide light should have compassion on those in darkness.
