"Do Not Be Fooled By Sin"

Accepting the notion of sin is arguably the most difficult doctrine for the world to embrace. To be called a sinner can be offensive to many, especially absent an explanation of the doctrine of grace, mercy, and the love of God. Rejecting sin in favor of self-righteousness grants permission to embellish what constitutes righteous or self-serving behavior. We live during a time that elevates the sinful nature of self-righteousness over the imputed righteousness of those who claim Jesus as Lord in their life. Isaiah 64:6 tells us that, "All of us have become like one who is unclean, And all our righteous deeds are like a filthy garment." The Bible tells us that belief and baptism cleanse us of sin, and that forgiveness of sin required a blood sacrifice, the blood of Christ. Don't be fooled by sin. Although difficult to embrace, it remains the primary adversary in having a right relationship with God.
