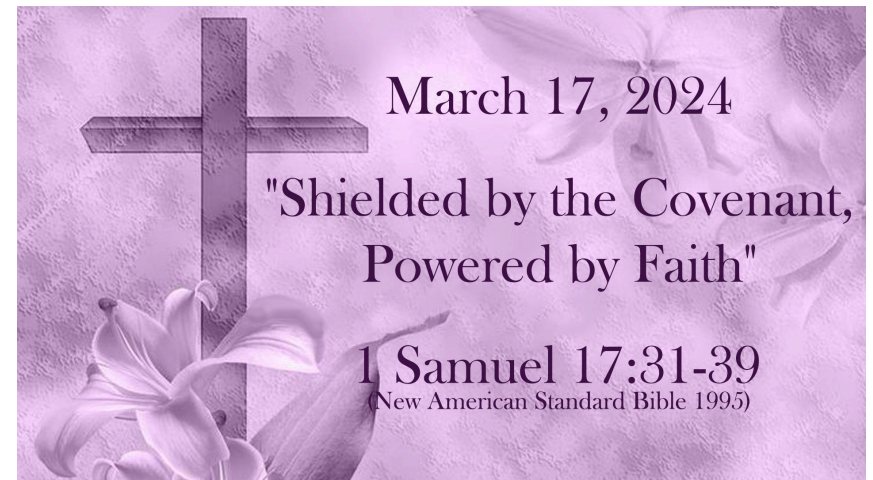

Preacher's Corner



"Thanks, But No Thanks"

The first chapter of Daniel provides a description of the events following the Babylonian siege of Judah. God allowed king Nebuchadnezzar to possess the city and its inhabitants. Many were killed and many were sent into exile. Daniel along with his three friends were chosen to serve the king because of their exceptional qualities. To prepare them for serving the king they would be given the best food, wine, and education. Daniel declined the offer to eat the king's choice of food and wine because he saw it as a defilement, instead preferring to depend on the Lord God for the best health and knowledge. Daniel 1:9 tells us that God granted Daniel favor in the sight of the commander of the officials and at the specified time of presenting to the king, no one was found like Daniel and his friends. The lesson here is although that which the world offers may look good and feel good, depending on and resting in the provisions of God renders better physical and spiritual outcomes.
